

## **OUTBACK ADVENTURE**

### **Shooting Sports Program**

**Outback** (out'back) into the open and in the back area

**Adventure** (ad ven'cher) *n.* an exciting and strenuous undertaking

The **Outback Adventure** program is offered to those scouts who are **14 years of age and above**. The program is designed to offer your older Scout's an opportunity to do some more advanced programs, and still be able to work on merit badges if they need to. All of the activities offered at the Outback Adventure program area will be on the same time schedule as our Merit Badge programs. The programs that are offered in the morning schedule will be offered again in the afternoon schedule. This will allow your Scouts to either take a morning or afternoon Merit Badge without missing any of the programs offered in the Outback Area. If your Scouts are not taking any Merit Badges they can go to both the morning and afternoon programs.

#### **Some but not all of the programs that will be offered are:**

Black Powder shooting  
Cross Bow shooting  
Sling shot shooting

Tomahawk throwing  
Field Archery  
Digglers Scooters

Mountain Boarding  
Biking  
Rafting (add. Cost)

In addition to the programs offered at the Outback Adventure area the Scouts will be able to take advantage of our Disc golf course, Mountain Biking, Mountain Boarding and Hiking programs.

There will be an **additional cost of \$14** per scout to take part in this program. Scouts may be signed up when units complete the on-line Merit Badge sign-up process. When the Scout arrives at camp he may purchase at the Trading Post an Outback Adventure Pass, which gives him access to the Outback Adventure area all week.

The Outback Adventure area will also be open for adult use during program times if there is space available. **As with all our programs the Scouts come first.**
